1. FURNISH VIRGINIA DMV A COURT RECEIPT INDICATING YOU HAVE COMPLIED WITH THE CITATION. PAYMENT AND/OR QUESTIONS SHOULD BE DIRECTED TO THE APPROPRIATE COURT, NOT DMV. THE COURT'S TELEPHONE NUMBER IS LISTED ABOVE WHEN AVAILABLE.
2. PAY DMV A \$145 REINSTATEMENT FEE. BEGINNING 07/01/2011, ALONG WITH THE REINSTATEMENT FEE, VIRGINIA LAW REQUIRES PAYMENT OF A \$5 FEE FOR EACH ADDITIONAL SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION ORDER IN EFFECT WHEN REINSTATING DRIVING PRIVILEGES.

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2004, VIRGINIA LAW REQUIRES ANYONE REINSTATING THEIR DRIVER'S LICENSE BECAUSE OF A LICENSE SUSPENSION, REVOCATION OR CANCELLATION TO PROVE THEIR LEGAL PRESENCE IN THE UNITED STATES. THEREFORE, TO REINSTATE YOUR DRIVING PRIVILEGE, YOU NEED TO VISIT YOUR LOCAL DMV OFFICE, PROVIDE PROOF OF YOUR LEGAL PRESENCE AND OBTAIN ANOTHER VIRGINIA DRIVER'S LICENSE.
